Waves Audio employs emulation techniques that allow the capture of an audio system's frequency response. A process called Convolution processing is employed. This process is in the open market and free from any patents. All other product names, trademarks, or trade names are the names of their respective owners, which are in no way associated, connected nor affiliated with Nebulapresets.com, Henry Olonga or HKO Rights Ltd, or the Nebulapresets.com products. None have endorsed Nebulapresets.com's products in any way, form or fashion. These other product names, trademarks and trade names are used solely to identify and describe the third party products, the sonic behaviour of which was under reference study, used in producing tools in the Nebulapresets.com family of products. They also serve to accurately describe the functionality in terms of the sound aesthetic that one would expect to encounter in the products offered by Nebulapresets.com. Convolution technology serves to actually measure examples of the sonic impact of an original analogue product upon a digital Audio stream to actually superimpose the original electronically emulated product onto the digital stream. The final rendered file that is a result of this process creates an audio file that may adopt many of the characteristics of the original hardware but this deduction may be subjective and may not be perceived by a user as producing the exact same effects. Sample rate, Bit depth, Cables, converters, the air and post processing all play a role in creating a final product offered by Nebulapresets.com that is not entirely identical to the original product under test.
